# Preparation for Exercise, Lexiscan, and Adenosine Nuclear Stress Tests

- PLEASE BRING WITH YOU YOUR REFERRAL AND THE PHYSICIAN
  REQUEST / ORDER FOR YOUR TEST (If your test was ordered by a physician at
  Cardiovascular Consultants, your order will be at our office in your chart). A written
  order MUST BE presented (state law), or your test will be cancelled and you will be
  charged the cost of the isotope ordered specifically for your test.
- DO NOT CONSUME CAFFEINE THE DAY BEFORE AND THE DAY OF your test (this includes chocolate, coffee, tea & decaffeinated products -- see attached list).
- <u>DO NOT EAT 3 HOURS</u> PRIOR TO YOUR TEST.
- DRINK PLENTY OF WATER THE DAY BEFORE YOUR TEST & DRINK 2 CUPS
  OF WATER PRIOR TO COMING FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT. YOU DO NOT
  HAVE TO HAVE A FULL BLADDER FOR YOUR TEST.
- Avoid using any lotions, colognes, or powders on your chest on the day of the test.
   You may use deodorant and lotions elsewhere on your body.
- Wear comfortable tennis shoes and a short sleeve T- shirt. Women please
   wear a 2-piece outfit a button down shirt is ideal.
- No smoking after 10 pm the night prior to your test.
- Your test takes approximately 3-5 hours to complete. Several 40 minute rest
  periods are required portions of this test. You may wish to bring reading materials
  and a snack with you. You will be able to eat after the exercise or pharmacologic
  portion of your test.

- DO NOT TAKE Beta blockers the day before or the day of the test (36-48 hours prior to your test) (unless otherwise advised by your physician). You may resume after testing is completed. (see attached list)
- DO NOT TAKE calcium channel blockers the day before the test or the day of the test (36 – 48 hours prior to your test) (unless otherwise advised by your physician). You may resume after testing is completed. (see attached list)
- <u>DO NOT TAKE</u> theophylline containing preparations the day before the test or the day of your test (unless otherwise advised by your physician). You may resume after testing is completed. (see attached list)

\*Please Note: Failure to provide 24-hour notice or to follow the instructions will result in your being billed \$125.00 for the cost of the nuclear isotope purchased for your test, which is not covered by insurance.

## **Supplemental List**

Please pay attention to the requirements listed below. <u>If these instructions are not followed, you will NOT be able to have your test performed and WILL be charged the cost of the nuclear isotope.</u>

1. <u>DO NOT</u> take the following medications called beta blockers (listed below) the day before or the day of the test (36-48 hours prior to your test) unless otherwise directed by your physician.

2. <u>DO NOT</u> take the following medications called calcium channel blockers the day before your test or the day of the test unless approved and directed by your physician.

3. <u>DO NOT</u> take the following medications containing Theophylline the day before the test (24 hours prior to your test) unless otherwise directed by your physician.

Slo-Phyllin Uniphyl

4. <u>Caffeine interferes with your test and the results</u>. If caffeine is consumed, your <u>test will require cancellation</u>. \*\*\*DO NOT EAT / DRINK Caffeinated products the day before or the day of the test prior to stress testing\*\*\*\*
